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## Notice Municipality of Yarmouth Land Use By-Law Amendment

In accordance with Section 210(3) of the Municipal Government Act the Council of the Municipality of Yarmouth at a duly held Council meeting held on October 28, 2009 amended Part 23 Section 5 (c) of the Land Use By-Law to increase the required minimum setback distance of buildings, tructures, pen areas, manure piles, manure storage facilities a d burial sites for the disposal of dead animals used in connect on with mink and fox ranches, hog and fowl operations from three hundred and twenty-eight (328') feet to five hundred (500') feet from any off-site waterwell or any watercourse or waterbody. The amendment will affect all areas of the Municipality of Yarmouth zoned Rural Development (RD) and the portion of the Airport Noise Restriction (A2) Zone which is in the Rural Development designation.

The decision of Council amending the By-La w may be appealed by an aggrieved person, the applicant, the Director, a village in which the property is situated, or the Council of an adjoining Municipality. An appeal shall be served on the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board within fourteen days of the publication of the notice of adoption of the amendment.
